1. Introduction

The "Europe Meets Africa 2025" is a closed high-level forum designed to equip African stakeholders with the knowledge, strategies, and networks required to access EU project funding, investment opportunities as well as to recognize individuals and governments that demonstrate outstanding commitment, innovation and impact in implementing climate education, sustainability and green development. As part of Nigeria's effort to strengthen international partnerships for education, climate action, and sustainable development, Greening Education Partnership (GEP) Nigeria is leading a delegation of key stakeholders to these events.

This Expression of Interest (EOI) invites the State Government, Ministries and Agencies to nominate at least two delegates including State GEP Coordinators per MDA for participation in the workshop to build capacity in EU funding mobilization, establish strategic collaborations, and position the state for international project financing opportunities.

3. Benefits of Participation

- * State Universal Basic Education Board (SUBEB)
- State Investment Promotion & Public-Private Partnership Office
- Other relevant agencies and institutions

Delegates should hold leadership or technical positions with responsibilities in policy, project implementation, or international funding mobilization.

5. Participation Fee & Inclusions

The Participation Fee depends on Category selection. There are 3 categories of Participation namely:

The Participation fee covers:

- Workshop Registration Access to all sessions, networking events, and training materials.
- Visa Processing Assistance Support in obtaining travel documents.
- ❖ Hotel Accommodation at a designated partner hotel.
- Local Transportation Airport transfers and daily transportation to the venue.
- Meals & Refreshments Breakfast, lunch, and coffee breaks during the event.
- Post-Workshop Engagement Follow-up strategy sessions and proposal development support.
